Thank you for your OIA request. We respond as follows:

Question 1. Greenhouse gas emissions associated with natural hazards is not an area in which NIWA has done extensive research. Attached are the two relevant papers we were able to locate.

Question 2. We do not hold this information. I suggest contacting other relevant agencies, such as GNS Science and Scion, to ask whether they have any relevant papers authored by their scientists. I would also suggest examining the references in the attached papers for any other papers that may be helpful to you.
