Covid-19 Information

The University of Canterbury is following the Ministry of Education Guidelines for the tertiary sector (<https://www.education.govt.nz/covid-19/advice-for-tertiary-providers/whare-wananga/covid-19-protection-framework-advice-for-tertiary-education-providers/>) in response to the Covid-19 Protection Framework (traffic light system) (<https://covid19.govt.nz/traffic-lights/covid-19-protection-framework/>). Therefore the University has implemented risk assessment to determine specific vaccination requirements for each traffic light, Red, Orange and Green, in accordance with Government guidance. Campus is currently operating in the Orange setting (<https://covid19.govt.nz/traffic-lights/life-at-orange/>).

The existing Government Health Order (<https://www.health.govt.nz/our-work/diseases-and-conditions/covid-19-novel-coronavirus/covid-19-response-planning/covid-19-epidemic-notice-and-orders#phrv>) has already informed our approach for staff and students working in the Health and Education sectors to ensure they are vaccinated to meet those sector requirements. In addition to the Government-mandated roles, the University's risk assessment has identified higher risk roles and activities that will require proof of vaccination:

- All staff, students, attendees, workers, and visitors attending UC events are required to show their 'My Vaccine Pass' on arrival.
- Consistent with UC's commitment to safety within all campus settings, we are supporting our four student accommodation partners in establishing vaccination requirements for all Hall residents and staff.
- Any overnight stays at UC field research stations.
- Qualifications that require placement in the community including schools, early childhood centres and medical facilities.

More details on all of these requirements are provided below.

At UC we strive to create a campus culture of belonging, understanding, inclusiveness and caring. Any signs of discrimination surrounding a virus that doesn't discriminate on race or religion will not be tolerated. Please be compassionate and kind, we are all in this together.
