Vaccinations

Vaccines administered to date (percentage of eligible people):

- 3,985,095 first doses (95%)
- 3,886,724 second doses (92%)
- 33,993 third primary doses
- 637,058 booster doses

Māori (percentage of eligible people):

- 504,769 first doses (88%)
- 472,228 second doses (83%)

Pacific Peoples (percentage of eligible people):

- 273,461 first doses (95%)
- 263,598 second doses (92%)

Hospitalisations

34 cases in hospital:

- 4 in North Shore
- 8 in Auckland
- 17 in Middlemore
- 4 in Tauranga
- 1 in Waikato

Cases

28 new community cases:

- 9 in Auckland
- 3 in Waikato
- 5 in Bay of Plenty
- 2 in Lakes
- 4 in Wairarapa
- 2 in Hutt Valley
- 3 in Canterbury
