 Government has placed a 72-Hour hold on 'Quarantine-free' entry. Bookings for 'Quarantine-free' travel from the 25th 28th January 2021 will receive contact directly of any changes to your service once further advice has been received from the Australian Government.
- From 11:59 pm on Monday 25 January 2021, most passengers travelling to New Zealand must provide evidence of a negative COVID-19 test result before departure. Customers transiting through New Zealand from the United Kingdom and the United States must also meet this requirement. Learn more.
- From 26 January 2021, Air New Zealand requires all passengers to wear a face-covering on international flights. Face-coverings are already required by local legislation on all New Zealand domestic flights and on flights to some international destinations.
