Kia ora,

The Institute has been tracking the progress of the inaugural Long Term Insights Briefings (LTIBs) of government departments from 2021 to date. We have recorded in a table the process of development of the LTIBs. This lists key information such as: whether briefings have been created by an individual department or produced in collaboration; the time horizon of the briefings; and consultation duration. The table also provides a central location where the LTIBs, along with the consultation documents, can be accessed. The table can be found <a href="here">here</a> on our <a href="here">website</a>.

The table is almost complete, however, there is one point of clarification needed to finalise the content regarding the Ministry for Pacific Peoples (MPP) final LTIB and the draft LTIB for consultation.

In our records, MPP's draft LTIB released as part of the second round of public consultation (<u>see here</u> – accessed via MPP's LTIB webpage on 24 January 2023) appears to be the same document as the final LTIB (<u>see here</u> – noted by MPP as being published in August 2023).
