As part of the existing contract (354410/00) between the Ministry of Health (Ministry) and Quality and Safety International (QSi), I confirm the Ministry's following additional order for the manufacture [and delivery] by QSi of:

QSi has advised that the above prices reflect its costs as at 24 March 2020.

Both parties recognise the potential impacts of the current COVID-19 pandemic on supply chains, which could result in changes to cost of goods. Both parties will operate in good faith to adjust pricing under this order to reflect genuine changes in cost of goods, both increasing and decreasing. QSi will provide open book pricing to support discussions and agreement of price changes, if required.


A 10-year shelf life must be guaranteed for all masks and the required ASTM F2100-04 standards maintained for general purpose masks.
